

## Attendance Policy and Procedures

- A. This Attendance policy is tied to the attendance requirements as listed in the Bylaws
  - 1. Currently the Bylaws state:
    - a. Any three consecutive missed regular Central Committee meetings, without notification to the secretary, may remove the member from the Central Committee.
    - b. Any four missed regular Central Committee meetings during a twelve month period may remove the member from the Central Committee.
    - c. The member may petition the Executive Committee for retention on the Central Committee.
- B. A member may petition the Executive Committee via email, U.S. mail, or in person.
- C. A member may not appeal to the Executive Committee in advance of missing a meeting.
- D. If a member anticipates upcoming issues with missing one or more meetings, they may email the Secretary to document their situation.
- E. If the Executive Committee approves retention of the member, this does not negate current attendance requirements.
